

## Choirs

### Classes Will Consist Of:

- Two or three choirs scheduled per session.
- Each choir will perform and receive an oral and written adjudication, by a prominent adjudicator.
- Marks will not be awarded. This program is designed to be non-competitive as a learning experience for both the choir **leader & the participants**.
- Each choir will receive a certificate.
- The adjudicator will proceed to work with the groups, in a clinic-style presentation.

### Each Senior Choir is required to prepare the following:

1. A *harmonized* hymn that the choir would sing for a regular worship service.
2. One anthem that would be sung as part of the regular worship service.

### Format:

Each choir will sing their hymn and anthem for the clinician. They will receive approximately 15 minutes of time with the clinician; working on these pieces with constructive comments/critique.

We would like to create a spirit of cooperation within the various worship choirs of the community, and to encourage the appreciation of all styles of sacred choral music.

## **School Clinics**

We always endeavor to match up groups of similar age and experience.

### **Classes Will Consist Of:**

- Two or three bands/choirs scheduled per session.
- Each band/choir will perform two selections and receive an oral and written adjudication, by a prominent adjudicator.
- Marks will not be awarded. This program is designed to be non-competitive as a learning experience for both the choir/**band leader & the participants.**
- Each group will receive a certificate.
- The adjudicator will proceed to work with the groups, in a clinic-style presentation.
