

## **Video Submission Instructions 2023**

**\*\*\*These instructions apply ONLY to Provincial qualifying classes in the 28 years & under categories, and Canada West qualifying classes in the 22 years & under categories\*\*\***

### **Video Recording**

- Submissions must be recorded in a continuous video, no editing permitted.
- Video recordings can be simple recordings, filmed on a mobile device, as long as the audio is of decent quality.
- For piano submissions, please ensure that the video is taken from an angle that shows hands while playing.

### **Video Uploads**

- You will need to create a YouTube account and upload your video there. It is up to you if you make the video public or unlisted. DO NOT set it as private, or the adjudicator will not be able to view it.
- Please title the video on YouTube with the participant's name and song selection.

### **Email Submissions**

- Please put the performer's name and the **class number** (NOT class name) in the subject line.
- For performers with multiple entries, please submit a new email for each class.
- Email must contain the video link and a copy of the sheet music in pdf format.
- **Emails submissions are to be sent to [moosejawmusicfestival@hotmail.com](mailto:moosejawmusicfestival@hotmail.com) and must be received by March 11 2023 at 9:00 pm.**

Please note that there will be no assistance available from the Moose Jaw Music Festival to create or upload videos, as we do not have the required expertise in those areas to advise others. If you require assistance with video creation or upload, you will need to ask a friend, family member, or colleague to assist you. The deadline for submission of videos is **March 11 2023 at 9pm**. In order to allow time for any technical issues you might encounter, please do not wait until the last minute to submit.
